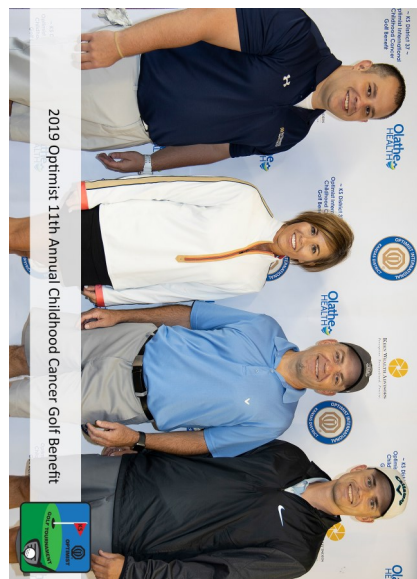

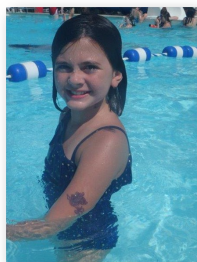
There are three Childhood Cancer camps that serve Kansas Kids. These camps provide children, diagnosed with cancer, an opportunity to have a week of fun and activities and time to just to be kids! Qualified staff provide the necessary medical support to meet individual health needs while camp companions and volunteers ensure one-on-one supervision for

each child. The staff creates a caring and supportive environment and create bonds of friendship that transcend beyond the week of camp. Parents get a well-earned week of rest, and sometimes a sibling is also accepted at camp.

Camp is not a stand-alone, as parents and children receive year-round support through planned year-long activities that bring the volunteers and families together for fun and continued emotional support.

Both, Camp Quality Kansas and Camp Quality Greater Kansas City are part of seventeen childhood cancer camps that are affiliated with Camp Quality USA. Together, they will serve over 150 children ages 4-18. They also take some siblings.

Camp Hope Heartland will serve 100 children ages 5-17, most of whom are from Kansas, for the week-long camp and some children ages 4-6 attend for one-day only.



As long as there are children with cancer, Kansas District of Optimists will continue to support Camp Quality Kansas, Camp Quality Greater Kansas City, and Camp Hope Heartland as they serve our Kansas Kids!

They have given \$228,324 to the childhood cancer camps to support for kids with cancer. Annually 15-20 kids are provided a free week of camp. Additionally, the District provides individual assistance to families if a need is identified.

Kansas clubs are also involved in the Optimist International Childhood Cancer Campaign. In December 2009, a one-million dollar pledge was completed to provide a research chair at Johns Hopkins to support childhood cancer research. Optimist International continues to honor their pledge so that the research can continue. Local clubs support families with children that have been diagnosed with cancer. We raise extra funds through our “Brown Bag” project to provide camp supplies and clubs also host special Childhood Cancer fundraisers.
